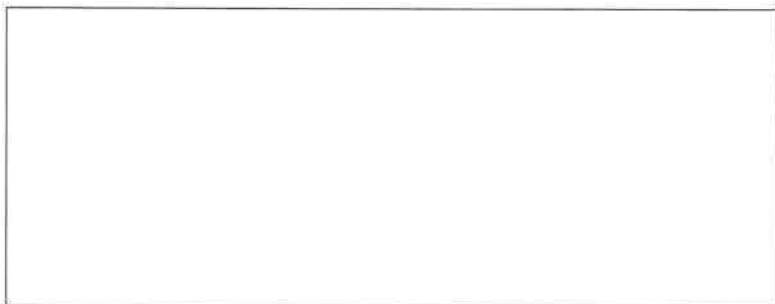

## ASK THE REV

What is the basis of our calendar year date?

Our calendar date is based on the birth of Christ. Dating of the years is thus based on **B.C.** (before Christ) or **A.D.** (Anno Domino) which is Medieval Latin that means "Year of our Lord." Any year before the birth of Christ is thus suffixed with B.C. meaning the number of years before Christ's birth. Our present dating of Christ's birth was established by Dionysius Exiguus in the 6<sup>th</sup> century. Since our calendar has been accepted among people of many religions, the terms A.D. and B.C. have been replaced in many academic literature as **CE** (common era) and **BCE** (before the common era). The best guess of most Biblical scholars is that Jesus was born between 4 and 7 B.C. although a recent suggestion has placed his birth at 1 BC. The current year accurately

timed could be anywhere from 2024 to 2030. It is interesting that even the world dating system is based on the most significant birth in history. Even the secular humanists who have nothing to do with Christianity, acknowledge (whether they are aware of it or not) the birth of Christ each time they deal with any type of date. As Christians we can also celebrate the date as the birth of the one who would take all our sins upon Himself so that we can have eternal life. Every time we write or state the current date we can celebrate our freedom in Christ!

## Thank You Antioch

Sunday, June 25, 2023 is another memorable day in my life at Antioch in Princess Anne. It is difficult to put into words how touched I was when Christy Scott began to talk about recognizing a long-time member of Antioch and I realized I was that person.

July 5, 1958 was the date Lester and I were married and Antioch became my church. The organist was Esther Riffin who played at Antioch for 50 years. She was excited when my mother-in-law told her I could play the organ. What they didn't know as it was just for one summer with a half hour lesson from my piano teacher and the words "You will figure it out".

Until John Evans was hired, I either played full time or to fill in for other organists. If you look on the organ, you may find the music to Happy Birthday and a pair of magnifying

glasses. Memorizing music is not one of my assets.

Over the years jokes have been made about playing barefooted. When I retired once after getting a trained organist, Rick Nelson when presenting me with money said it was so I could buy a pair of shoes.

At one time, Antioch had 2 morning services at 8 and 11 and I would play for both. I enjoyed working with a children's choir who walked to practice on Fridays from school. There was a youth choir and an adult choir.

Along with teaching school for 33 years, being the parent of two children, Antioch was where I expected to be on Sunday morning unless I was sick or on family vacation or traveling for work.

After I retired, I was able to be involved with Sharing / Caring for a number of years and as chair for the past few years.

There are many others at Antioch who are deserving of the honor I received today. June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023 will remain a special day in my life. Thank you for the beautiful flowers, the gift and gift cards.

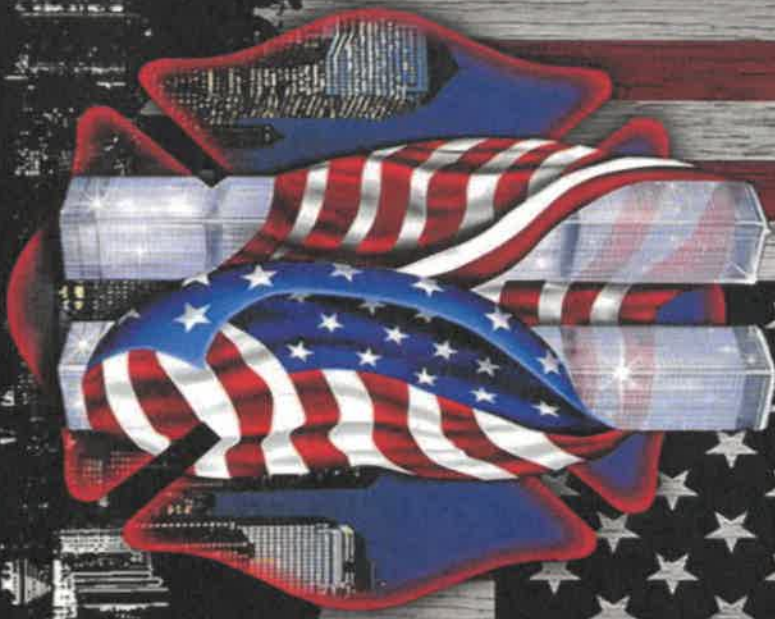
