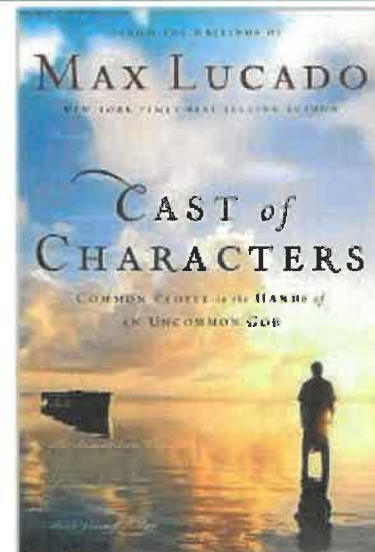

The regular monthly meeting of Antioch's Sharing/Caring was held on Wednesday, March 16th. 17 lunches were delivered by Mary Evans, Gene Howe, Jill DeCesare, and Joyce Benson with help from Cindy Powell. Seven members and Pastor Steve were in attendance.

The Lunch Ministry has been a monthly project of Sharing and Caring and you are invited to share the names of individuals in the community or church who need and would appreciate this outreach contact. Easter bags will be delivered to shut-ins before our next meeting, Lynn Benson and Christy Scott will work on this project.

Sharing/Caring has many community projects including the Seton Center, Hope Ministries, and the Lower Shore Homeless Shelter. Baskets for requested supplies can be found in the vestibule of the church. Jill reported that Seton Center among other things, needs 14 oz. dish detergent and that they are again accepting clothing items. The Center is open during weekdays. We hope that you can help them to meet their needs.

Our group also supports the Lower Shore Homeless Shelter. Dick Scott reported that this winter has been a difficult one for the homeless. Many of us had heard about homelessness in other counties, but were unaware that it is also happening here in

Somerset. We are going to increase our efforts to help them.

Antioch has a real need to update its technology system. Sharing/Caring is going to aid this project by holding a bake sale on Friday, May 6 on Main Street in front of the beauty salon. We are asking for your help. Bring any bake sale items to the Fellowship Hall on Thursday, between 5 and 7 p.m. where the items will be packaged and priced for sale on Friday morning starting at 8 a.m. We want to let the community know that we are back in the bake sale fundraising. Over the years we have supported many fundraisers. This is your invitation to help.

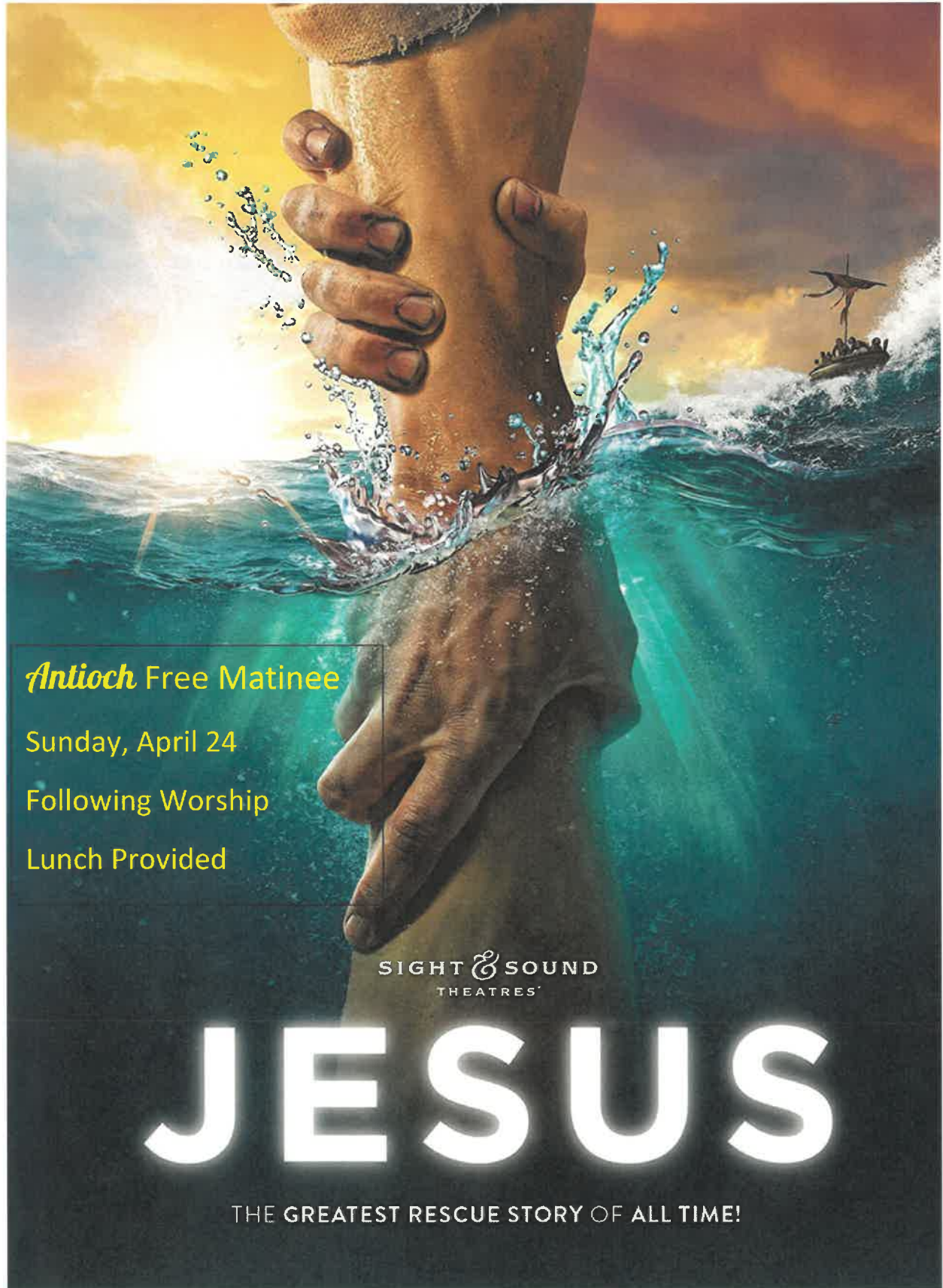
